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# Make Ten and Some More 

K:12 Draw 16 circles. Use a [favorite color] marker for 10 of them. Use a pencil for the rest. [Student draws.]
How many are [favorite color]? How many are in pencil?
Write the missing number: $16=10+$ $\qquad$

# This task is delivered verbally using an Interview format. 

Student materials: color markers, pencil, blank paper

Teacher instructions
Notes

1. Allow the student to choose a color marker for the task. Have a pencil ready, also. Say to the student, "I would like you to draw sixteen circles. Use the [color] marker to draw ten circles. Use a pencil to draw the rest of the circles."
2. After the student has finished working, say:
"How many circles are [color]? How many circles are in pencil?"
3. Next, write $\mathbf{1 6}=\mathbf{1 0}+$ $\qquad$ . Point to the blank space and say, "16 equals 10 plus what number? Write the missing number here."
