## **Make Ten and Some More**

marker for 10 of them. Use a pencil for
the rest. [Student draws.]
How many are [favorite color]? How many
are in pencil?

Student materials: color markers, pencil, blank paper

## Teacher instructions

## <u>Notes</u>

- Allow the student to choose a color marker for the task. Have a pencil ready, also. Say to the student, "I would like you to draw sixteen circles. Use the [color] marker to draw ten circles. Use a pencil to draw the rest of the circles."
- 2. After the student has finished working, say: "How many circles are [color]? How many circles are in pencil?"
- 3. Next, write 16 = 10 + \_\_\_. Point to the blank space and say, "16 equals 10 plus what number? Write the missing number here."
